EPA Webinar to Discuss Beneficial Use Risk Evaluation Methodology and Study on Fly Ash Concrete and Synthetic Gypsum Wallboard

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency has scheduled a webinar for coal ash industry stakeholders and coal ash users on **Thursday, February 27, 2014, from 1:00 – 2:00 PM EST** to discuss the Agency's recently released methodology for evaluating risks of encapsulated beneficial uses of coal ash. The webinar will also review the EPA's use of that methodology in a study that concluded the use of coal fly ash in concrete and synthetic gypsum in wallboard are safe and appropriate beneficial uses.
